### APEX FLOAT REPLACEMENT MANUAL



#### WARNING!

Disconnect Portacool from electrical source before servicing.



Models: PACA12001A1, PACA20001A1, PACA40001A1 and PACA65001A1

#### **Before Beginning:**

- Move unit to safe work environment.
- Position Portacool with plenty of working room on all sides.
- Disconnect Portacool from electrical and water supplies.

#### **Tools Needed:**

- Drill Driver with a 5/16-inch socket.
- Channellock Wrench
- Gloves and Safety Glasses

#### Steps:




Figure 1: Portacool Apex unit back view (left), Portacool Apex unit back view without media flap (right).

1. First, unscrew the Media Flap Screws using a 5/16" socket and remove the Media Flap. Pull the Distribution Media and all the Main Media out of the unit (Figure 1).

Start by setting the angle between the Valve Actuator and the Arm. Refer to Figure 2 for part nomenclature. To adjust the angle:

- a. Ensure that the Ball is detached from the Arm.
- b. Loosen the Adjusting Screw.
- c. Adjust the angle using any of the following methods:
- Using the template provided with the document (Figures 6 and 7).
  Place Replacement Float over the template and adjust the Arm to the correct position based on the unit model. Use Figure 6 for PAC12001A1. Use Figure 7 for PACA20001A1, PACA40001A1 and PACA65001A1
- Alternatively, use the Existing Float in the unit as a reference and match the angle of the Replacement Float accordingly.

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
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
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- d. Tighten the Adjusting Screw once the Arm is set to correct angle.
- e. Attach the Ball to the Arm
- 3. Depending on the Portacool Unit configuration, follow these steps:
  - a. Float Valve and ¾" Housing Fitting Configuration (Figure 3):
  - Remove the Existing Float from inside the unit. Gently use a Channellock Wrench if needed.
  - Attach the provided ¾" to ½" Adapter by wrapping 3-4 layers of PTFE thread sealing tape around the male threads of the Replacement Float (Figure 3).
  - Apply 3-4 layers of PTFE thread sealing tape to the male threads of the 34" to 1/2" Adapter, then securely fasten the Replacement Float to the 34" Housing Fitting, ensuring it is tightened properly (Figure 3). Gently use a Channellock Wrench if needed.



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




Figure 5: Portacool Unit Interior View with Float and Bracket Assembly.

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- b. Float Valve and Bracket/Routing Clamp Configuration (Figure 5):
  - Remove the Routing Clamp by removing the 2X Screws with a 5/16" socket (Figure 5).
  - Remove the Hose fitting and the Nut from outside and detach the Existing Float from inside the unit (Figure 4). Gently use a Channellock Wrench if needed.
  - Install the Replacement Float using the Washer and the Nut and attach the Hose Fitting (Figure 4). Ensure the Replacement Float and the Hose Fitting are tightened properly. Gently use a Channellock Wrench if needed.



• Reattach the Routing Clamp using the 2X Screws (Figure 5).

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


Figure 6: PACA12001A1 Float Angle Adjustment Template.




Figure 7: PACA20001A1, PACA40001A1, PACA65001A1 Float Angle Adjustment Template.
